



## Team and campsite regulations 3-nationscup Ranst

15/09-16/09-17/09

### 1. Opening hours and access

- The campsite is open from **FRIDAY 15/09/2023 15.00 hrs to SUNDAY 17/09/2023 19.00 hrs.**
- Arrival at the campsite is possible on Friday **15/09/2023 between 15:00 and 22:00 and on Saturday 16/09/2023 between 08:00 and 20:00**
- Access to the campsite is only possible after registration/payment in advance via <https://3nations.bmxranst.be/>
- Upon arrival, you will be escorted to your camping pitch by a person in charge.
- The pitches are simply contiguous, if you want to stand together with someone, you will arrive together. It is strictly forbidden to keep pitches free in between!
- The price for a camping pitch for camper vans is €80 if you book before 7 August (afterwards €95) for a pitch of 10 x 5 metres , €95 if you book before 7 August (afterwards €110 ) for a pitch of 15 x 5 metres and €80 if you book before 7 August (afterwards €95)for a pitch for a tent with a car.
- Wild camping in the area is strictly prohibited
- **Parking on carriageway or AVEVE parking is strictly prohibited.** Police will supervise and you will be towed away.
- Breakfast can be collected at the Welcome Centre, on Saturdays between 08:00 and 10:00 and Sundays between 07:00 and 08:00

### 2. Tent-area

- Access to the tent-area is only available after registration/payment in advance via <https://3nations.bmxranst.be/>
- Upon arrival at the Domain, you will receive 1 free entry ticket for the whole weekend
- The Tent-area is free for National Teams. All other teams/clubs/individual tents pay €60 for a 6 x 3 m pitch. After unloading equipment, the car will be moved to a nearby car park outside the Tent-area.
- Placing tents is possible on Friday 15/9 between 16.00 and 20.00 and on Saturday 16/9 between 07.00 and 08.00.

### 3. Safety and comfort

- Set up your equipment within the camping area allocated by the organisation. This is to avoid conflicts and keep evacuation routes clear.
- Weapons and drugs are not allowed in the campsite.
- It is forbidden to light fires on the campsite. This also means no barbecues, torches, candles or fireworks.
- Think of your camping companions who want to unwind after a hard day of sports. Keep (loud) music to a minimum. Keep it quiet on the campsite between 10pm and 8am.
- Our neighbours are our friends. Keep it that way!
- Store valuables properly. BMX club Ranst is NOT RESPONSIBLE for any thefts.
- **The organisation provides day and night surveillance on and around the campsite. Vandalism, theft, verbal and physical violence and other serious offences are NOT part of our sport. All serious infringements will be reported to the local police without discussion. The organisation reserves the right to deny offenders access to the campsite.**

### 4. Waste

- Please dispose of your waste in the waste bags and bins provided. We expect your pitch to be clean when you leave the campsite.

### 5. Technical information

- We provide standard pitches of +/- 5m x 10 m or +/- 5m x 15 m for caravan/mobile home and pitches for a tent with car.
- Please make your choice online when booking your pitch. Changes cannot be made on site.
- Power and generators are switched off between 22.00 and 07.00 hrs.
- Shower and toilet containers are closed between 23.00 and 07.00. Dixies remain open during the night.
- Running water is only provided at the sanitary block.
